

SAFETY PROTOCOLS at PMAC - In-Person Instruction:

Things are going to look different at PMAC this year. You will see one-way directional signs around our space, and face coverings will be required for all persons in our building. PMAC has installed Merv-13 filters to our current HVAC system and additional Hepa air filtration units are located in each teaching space. We are dedicated to providing a safe environment for everyone in our building. This quick guide will share new protocols for students who are able to study in person at our building.

SAFETY PROTOCOL - ONSITE at PMAC:

Students must follow basic safety protocols while in our building. Here are the quick rules:

- All Students must observe social distancing (6FT in between each other) in our building.
- Everyone must wear a face covering inside our building, including during classes/rehearsals.
- All students must wash their hands when they enter the building, before participating in their PMAC program.
- Students may not touch each other's instruments or art supplies.
- All persons must follow the one-way directions around the space to get to and from their program.
- Our lobby is not available for gathering or waiting.
- Any persons who do not follow this safety protocol will be dismissed from their onsite program.

IF YOU OR YOUR CHILD FEELS SICK, please STAY HOME.

In the event that PMAC must close its building and shift to remote instruction, all students and families will be notified of the change.

STUDENT CHECK CHECK IN - WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Students will be greeted by Kate Bogosian and Phyl Giordano, our Administrative Assistants in the Front Lobby.
- All students must arrive with their face coverings on. If you forget your face covering, PMAC has new, disposable paper masks available for anyone who needs one.
- Kate or Phyl will ask a few wellness questions.
- After the wellness check, all students will be asked to go to the bathrooms to wash their hands.
- After hands are washed thoroughly, students can join their program at PMAC.
- Please arrive on time, but not early (PMAC's lobby is not currently available for waiting).

INDIVIDUAL LESSON INSTRUCTION - ONSITE

For the Fall Semester, we are providing a limited number of in-person lessons. Details are below:

- Lesson Studios at PMAC have shifted to PMAC's large ensemble rooms to support social distancing.
- Students must maintain a 6FT distance in between their instructors during their lesson program.
- All students must wear face coverings during their lesson program.
- All PMAC instruments, music stands, tables and chairs used during the student's lesson will be disinfected after each lesson.
- An in-person lesson student may request a remote lesson at any time.
- Students must always bring their own folder and pencil, along with their instrument (if applicable), art supplies and any accessories that they need for their lesson.
- Please arrive on time, but not early (PMAC's lobby is not currently available for waiting).
- Any persons who do not follow this safety protocol will be dismissed from their onsite program.

LESSON STUDENTS UNDER AGE 10 - ONSITE

Within our youth protection policy, we have requested that parents/guardians of students under age 10 remain onsite during the student's PMAC program. We will not have a waiting area for parents/guardians this semester. Instead, we ask the following:

- Parents/Guardians may attend the lesson with their child.

- Parents/Guardians who choose to not attend the lesson with their child, need to stay close by (outside or in their cars); Please do not leave the PMAC property so that you can be available during your child's lesson if needed.
- All parents who attend lessons with their children must follow the safety protocols stated above, including wearing a mask at all times while in the building.

MUSIC ENSEMBLE REHEARSALS - ONSITE

For the Fall Semester, we are providing a limited number of in-person ensemble meetings. Details are below:

- All Music Ensembles will be meeting in the Haas Family Gallery and Recital Hall - PMAC's largest classroom onsite.
- Each in-person ensemble is limited to 8 students.
- Students must maintain a 6FT distance in between their instructors and the other students during their rehearsal.
- All students must wear face coverings during their ensemble meeting.
- All PMAC instruments, music stands, tables and chairs used during the ensemble's rehearsal will be disinfected after each class.
- An ensemble student may request to participate in the class remotely at any time.
- Students must always bring their own folder and pencil, along with their instrument (if applicable), and any accessories that they need for their rehearsal.
- Please arrive on time, but not early (PMAC's lobby is not currently available for waiting).
- Any persons who do not follow this safety protocol will be dismissed from their onsite program.

ART CLASS MEETINGS - ONSITE

For the Fall Semester, we are providing a limited number of in-person art class meetings. Details are below:

- All Art Classes will be meeting in the Living Innovations Art Classroom - PMAC's largest art classroom onsite.
- Each Art Class is limited to 4 students per class.
- Students must maintain a 6FT distance in between their instructors and the other students during their class.
- All students must wear face coverings during their art class.
- All PMAC tables and chairs will be disinfected after each class.
- An art student may request to participate in the class remotely at any time.
- Parents and students will be notified of art supply protocols after signing up for a class.
- Any persons who do not follow this safety protocol will be dismissed from their onsite program.

COVID-19 ABSENCE

If a student or a member of the student's household has been diagnosed with or is suspected to have Covid-19, please follow CDC guidelines and quarantine for 14-days.
